Bank Charges Investigation

Dear Mr Weeks

I refer to an article in Beeld of May, 7, 2006 in connection with the ongoing investigation regarding the seemingly high banking charges applicable to SA Banks. I trust that I can address you in Afrikaans. You are welcome to use Afrikaans or English in your response.

I have been a client of Standard Bank of South Africa for more than 15 years. With the opening of my account in 1991 I enquired at all the major banks regarding their cost structures. I was previously a client of Volkskas (ABSA) for more than 30 years but experienced excessive price increases since 1985. My enquiries led me to the "Prestige Package" which Standard Bank offered. This package was very attractive at the time, since it resulted in a saving of between 10%-15% on all my transactions as a consulting engineer. It was also attractive for budget purposes since a fixed monthly fee applied to ALL transactions.

With time regular adjustments increased my transaction costs significantly, resulting in a poorer and more expensive service.

With the publishing of their new cost structures in 2004, Standard Bank invited comment. Hence I sent an enquiry to them.

My enquiry lead to a whole chain reaction which to date has not progressed any further. No progress has been made in 2 years as the bank is either not capable or willing to give a well reasoned reply regarding their cost policy. They are only promoting their services and are not transparent. Their administration is such that mistakes regularly appear on my statements which I have to have corrected time and again. The mistakes pertaining to the debiting of costs are always to the advantage of the bank and disadvantage of the customer.

You will notice that I have addressed this correspondence for the attention of Mr Jaco Maree but have to date not received a response or even acknowledgement of receipt. I attached hereto all the correspondence to date for your further information.

I trust that this information will be of assistance and of interest to you. It will be my pleasure to receive comments should the Commission wishes to make any.

I trust that your investigation will mean something to the client which I am convinced are being radically exploited. I can't accept that our banks system cannot be compared to those of other countries. The article also showed that with the implementation of electronic settling (clearing?), the banks greatest advantage and income earned is disproportionately high to the costs of delivering the service.

Ek vertrou dat ek hierdie skrywe in Afrikaans aan u kan rig. U is welkom om óf Afrikaans óf Engels in u reaksie te gebruik.

Ek is 'n klient van Standard Bank van Suid-Afrika vir meer as 15 jaar. By my plasing van my rekening in 1991 het ek 'n navraag by al die prominente Banke wat in my bereik sake gedoen het, gedoen i.v.m. wat hulle kostestrukture is. Ek was voorheen 'n klient van Volkskas (ABSA) vir meer as 30 jaar, maar het by hulle 'n buitensporige prysverhoging beleef vanaf 1985. My navrae het my gelei na die "Prestige Pakket" wat Standard Bank aangebied het. Hierdie pakket was op daardie stadium vir my aantreklik aangesien dit vir my transaksies, wat ek as Raadgewende Ingenieur bedryf het, 'n besparing van tussen 10% en 15% sou beteken. Vir begrotingsdoeleindes was dit ook aantreklik, want 'n vaste maandelikse fooi was van toepassing vir ALLE transaksies.

Met verloop van tyd het aanpassings egter gereeld verskyn wat die koste van my sake aansienlik verhoog het, en wat daartoe gelei het dat ek 'n swakker en duurder diens ontvang het.

By verskyning van hulle nuwe prysstruktuur het Standard Bank gedurende 2004 'n uitnodiging om kommentaar gerig. Dit het daartoe gelei dat ek 'n navraag na hulle deurgestuur het.

Op my navraag het 'n hele kettingreaksie gevolg wat tot op hede nog niks verder gevorder het nie. Dit is nou al 2 jaar sonder enige vordering aangesien die Bank nie bereid of in staat is om goed gemotiveerde antwoorde te verskaf oor hulle kostebeleid nie. Hulle is altyd net met reklame besig en is gladnie deursigtig nie. Hulle administrasie is ook van so 'n aard dat daar gereeld foute op my state verskyn wat ek telkemale moet laat regstel. Die foute met die debitering van koste items is altyd tot voordeel van die bank en tot nadeel van die klient.

U sal oplet dat ek die navraag ook vir aandag van Mnr Jaco Maree gemerk het, maar tot datum nog geen reaksie, selfs van ontvangserkenning van hom gekry het nie.

Ek heg hierby vir u inligting al die korrespondensie aan wat gevoer is.

Ek vertrou dat die inligting vir u interessant en tot hulp sal wees. Indien u kommissie enige kommentaar wil lewer sal dit vir aangenaam wees om dit te ontvang.

Ek vertrou dat u ondersoek iets kan beteken vir die Suid-Afrikaanse Bankklient, wat ek oortuig is radikaal uitgebuit word. Ek kan nie aanvaar dat ons Bankwese nie met ander lande vergelyk kan word nie. Ook het die artikel getoon dat met die instelling van elektroniese verrekening, die banke die grootste voordeel en inkomste verdien wat buite verhouding is met die koste om die dienste te voorsien.
