Competition Commission appoints Head of Enforcement and Exemptions

The Commission has appointed Ms Nompucuko Nontombana as the Divisional Manager of the Enforcement and Exemptions division with effect from 16 October 2015. Nontombana takes over from Junior Khumalo who has resigned and taken up a role at the Independent Communications Authority of South Africa (ICASA).

Nontombana has more than eight years competition policy experience having joined the Commission in 2007. She was a Principal Investigator in the Enforcement division for four years before joining the Mergers and Acquisitions division in 2011, leading the investigation of key cases in various sectors of the economy in both divisions.

Prior to joining the Commission, she worked in government in various capacities within the Department of Public Enterprises and as an Economist in the Department of Education.

Nontombana holds an Honours degree in Economics from the University of Cape Town and an MPhil (Economic Policy) from the University of Stellenbosch. She is currently completing her studies towards an MBL with Unisa's Graduate School of Business Leadership.
