TRANSPORT MARKET INQUIRY: LIMPOPO

The Competition Commission invites the media to the land based Public Passenger Transport Market Inquiry public hearings to be held at Protea Hotel in Polokwane on Tuesday and Wednesday, 21 to 22 August 2018.

The Commission is conducting a market inquiry into the land based public passenger transport sector to understand the general state of competition. There's a reason to believe that there are features in this sector that may prevent, distort or restrict competition.

The focus will include price setting mechanisms, price regulation, route allocation, allocation of operational subsidies, transport planning, and transformation in terms of ownership patterns in the land based public passenger transport industry.

Some of the organisations and companies that will testify include representatives from Great North Transport, SANCO, SANSBOC Limpopo, SANTACO, Bahwaduba Bus Service, Limpopo Department of Transport, Buscor, Polokwane Municipality, North West University and National Taxi Alliance.

Public hearings have already been held in Gauteng, Western Cape, KwaZulu Natal, Mpumalanga, Northern Cape, North West and Eastern Cape.
