TRANSPORT MARKET INQUIRY: WESTERN CAPE PUBLIC HEARINGS

The media is invited to Competition Commission's public hearings to be held in Cape Town from tomorrow.

The hearings will be held on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, 19 to 21 June 2018, in Southern Sun Cape Sun hotel, Strand Street.

The Commission is conducting a Transport Market Inquiry into the land based public passenger transport sector to understand the general state of competition. The Commission has reason to believe that there are features in the land based public passenger transport sector that may prevent, distort or restrict competition.

The focus will include price setting mechanisms, price regulation, route allocation, allocation of operational subsidies, transport planning, and transformation in terms of ownership patterns in the land based public passenger transport industry.

Some of the organisations and companies that will testify include representatives of CATA, CODETA, Cape Town City Council, Golden Arrow Bus Services, PRASA, and SANTACO.
