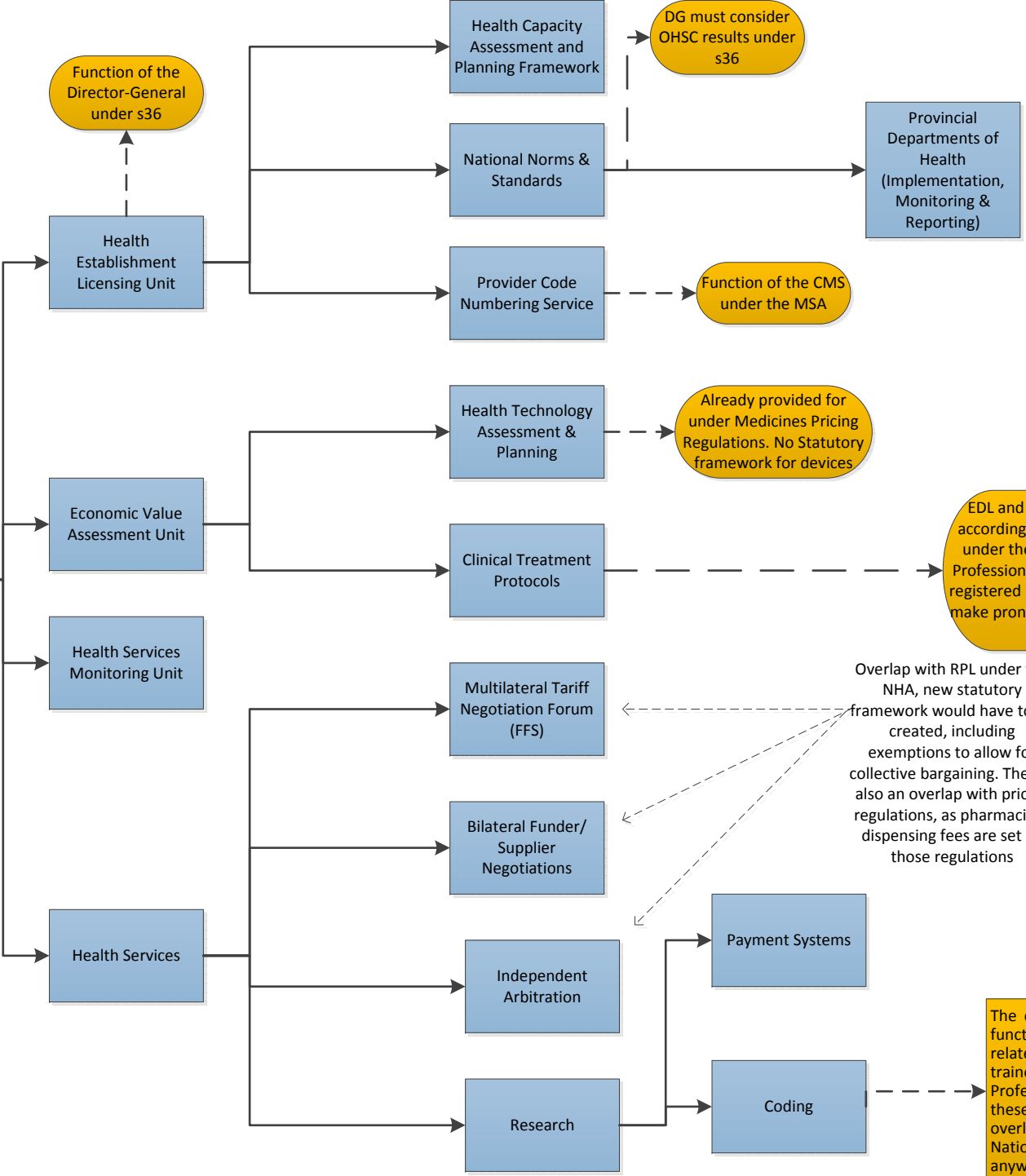


Supply-Side Regulator of Health



Function of the Director-General under s36

DG must consider OHSC results under s36

Function of the CMS under the MSA

Already provided for under Medicines Pricing Regulations. No Statutory framework for devices

EDL and EEL to be set according to regulations under the NHA; Health Professions Act gives only registered persons right to make pronouncements on care

Overlap with RPL under the NHA, new statutory framework would have to be created, including exemptions to allow for collective bargaining. There's also an overlap with pricing regulations, as pharmacists' dispensing fees are set by those regulations

The coding system as it expresses professional activities is a function of being registered at a professional council and relates to scopes of professions and what professionals are trained in and experienced to do. Therefore relates to Health Professions Act, Pharmacy Act, Nursing Act, etc. Under MSA these billing codes must appear on an invoice to a scheme. Also overlaps with record-keeping requirements to be set under National Health Act. In addition, ICD10 coding is not mandatory anywhere but under Regulations 5, MSA
