LATEST DECISIONS BY THE COMPETITION COMMISSION

1 Non-Referrals: The Commission has taken a decision to non-refer (not to prosecute) the following cases:

1.1 Themba Champion Mabizela v Thorough Tec

The Commission is of the view that the conduct complained of does not contravene the Competition Act.

1.2 Vuyani Timothy Spofana v Dankbaar Agencies

The Commission is of the view that the conduct complained of does not contravene the Competition Act.

1.3 Mabitsi MA v Moscow Corner Centre Cosmo City

The Commission is of the view that the conduct complained of does not contravene the Competition Act.
